Coming in Worship

Our sermon themes in the coming weeks will focus on the scenes and events surrounding the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

What a time of contrasts it was!
Jesus receives great public acclaim and then is crucified as a common criminal.

The shock and sorrow of his death is followed by the word that he is alive. Even his closest followers struggle to know what to believe. As the truth of the resurrection is confirmed for them they then begin to grapple with the implications of what this all means for them. Will they too share in this resurrection experience?

In those events long ago despair and hope are set in contrast with each other as the truth becomes known.

We too face this seeming contradiction between despair and hope as, in the course of our lives, we grow in the knowledge and love of our Lord Jesus Christ.
